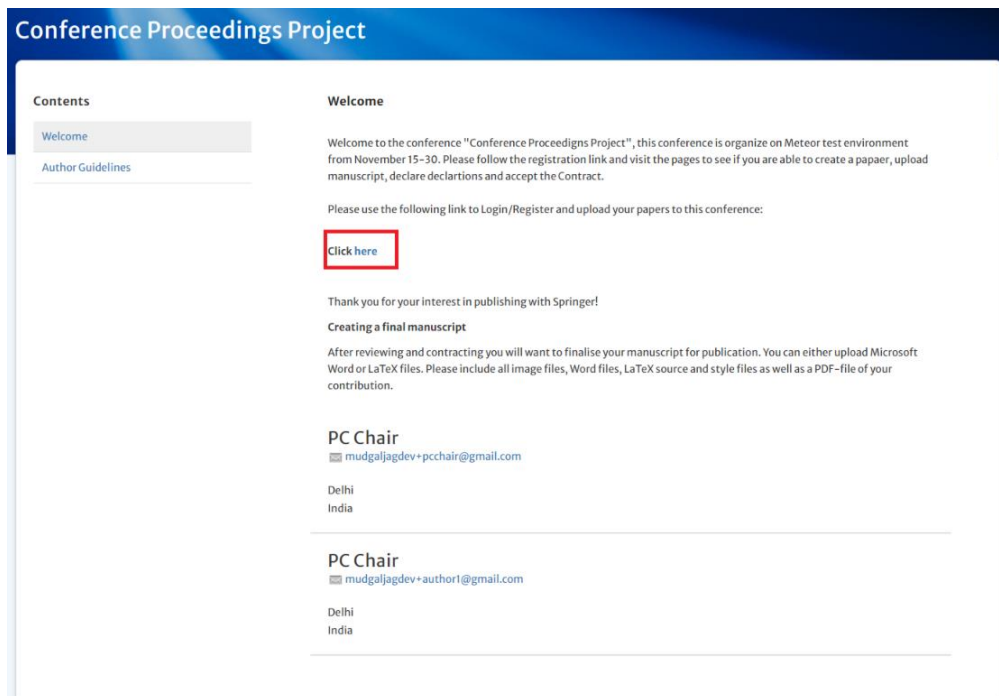
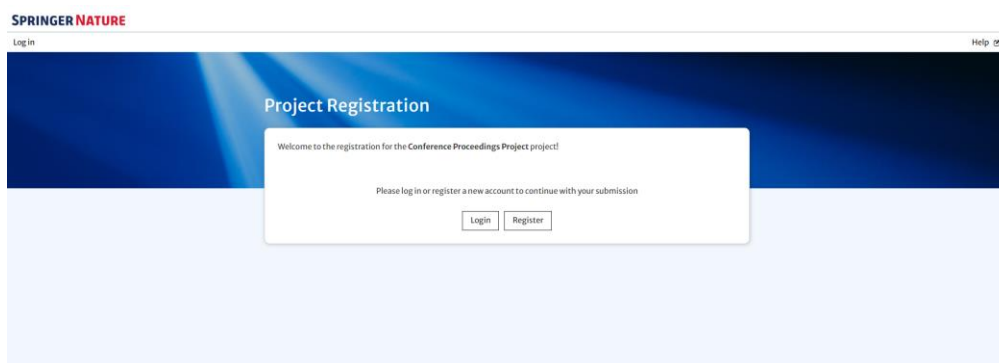

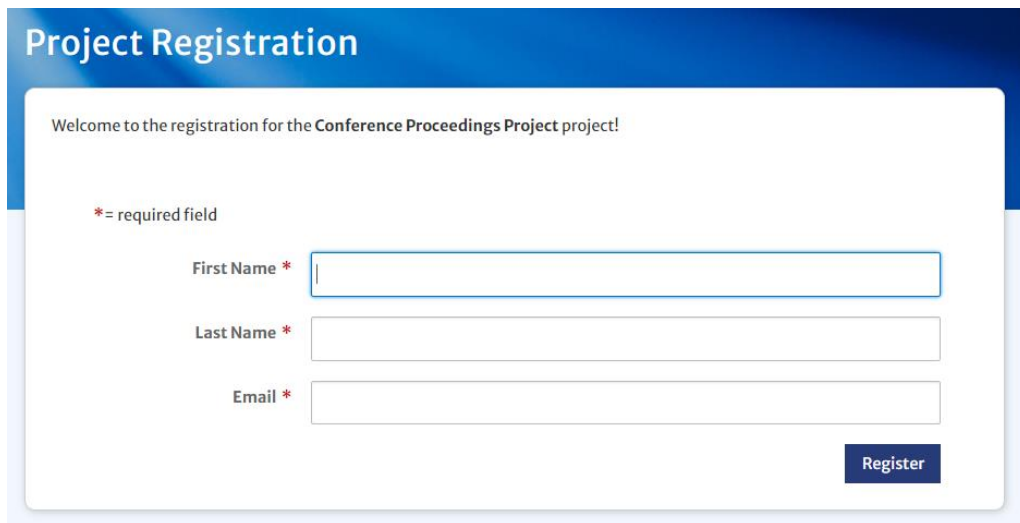
- Authors can login/Register to a conference project on Meteor system. Registration will give you access to the conference project

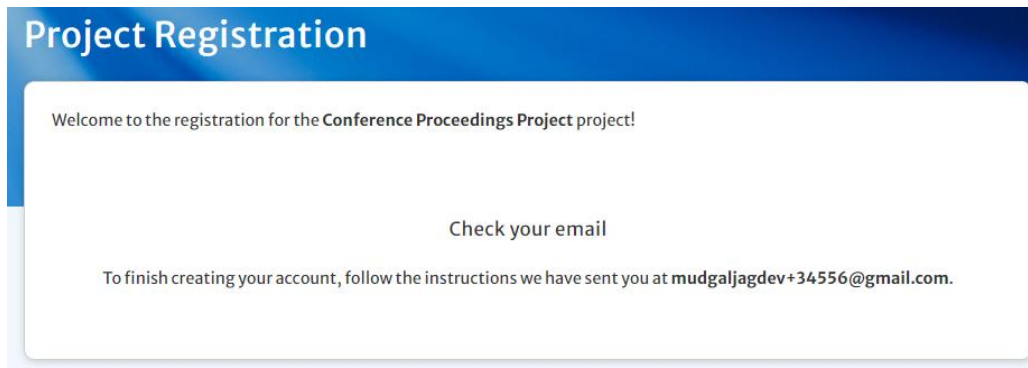
